Please remember to register for the FAI Competitors licence:

The FAI sporting licence (competitors' licence and not the SAHPA sports licence) expired on 31 December and will need to be renewed prior to the competition for your results to be accepted. You cannot register this at the competition as it will be too late to validate the sporting licence.

SAHPA recommends that all competition pilots pay their Aeroclub fees and competition licenses preferably by end of every January or at least a month before your first competition of the year.

***Note the system tracks you by ID number & email address, so to pay you need to login, if you have never logged in you will need to click forgotten password to reset your password by entering your ID & it will send the new password to the email address AeCSA has on file – if that does not work please call aeroclub on +27 11-0821100.

Please also make sure that your licence is current and if it needs to be renewed the forms are sent in at least a month before the competition to ensure that you have a valid licence on hand to show the organisers at the competition.

Please note that all pilots using the site:

- must be current members of SAHPA whether that be a student, licensed or foreign temporary member.
